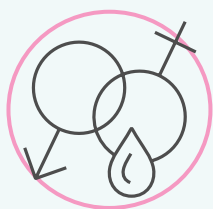


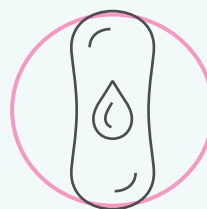
Symptom checker

Cervical Cancer

Symptoms of cervical cancer include:



Vaginal bleeding that's unusual for you – including bleeding during or after sex, between your periods or after the menopause, or having heavier periods than usual



Changes to your vaginal discharge



Pain during sex



Pain in your lower back, between your hip bones (pelvis), or in your lower tummy

If you have another condition like fibroids or endometriosis, you may get symptoms like these regularly.
